### **SCREENRIGHTS INTERNATIONAL LOWERS ADMINISTRATION FEE**

Screenrights International has become even more competitive, with a reduction in its administration fee to 11%, making it one of the most cost effective ways to collect royalties from around the world.

The new administration fee, which has been set until 30 June 2009, enables rightsholders to collect retransmission and copying royalties from Europe, the United States and Canada for a low fee, no matter how small or large their catalogue may be. "Rightsholders who are currently ensuring that all their programs are registered with us for Australian retransmission royalties can make us work for them on a global level," International Relations Manager Maha Ismail said. "It's simple. When they receive their registration report from us, they just need to indicate that they would also like us to collect for them in overseas territories. It means they don't need to register data with another organisation, and they can be assured that the cost for this service is one of the most competitive in international collections."
